The relative humidity in the Sahara Desert is 25%, but did you know your winter household humidity might be as low as 5 - 15%? Adding a Carrier humidifier will add comfort to your home and eliminate these irritating conditions for your family.

Technology

- Easy maintenance and cleaning** of the treated pad ensures top performance. Pad can be removed easily through the access door on the front of the humidifier.
- Quiet operation** is provided by the exceptional design. On powered models, the precision-tuned fan and motor combination efficiently draws dry air through the evaporator pad. On bypass models, the furnace blower moves the air quietly through the humidifier. With both models, as dry air is drawn over the pad, water is delivered to the air in the form of vapor.
- Attractive and corrosion resistant thermoplastic cover** is designed to withstand high temperatures and impact for long-lasting durability. UV-resistant plastic will not deteriorate with exposure to ultraviolet light sources.
- Optimum moisture distribution** is measured and controlled through our combined solenoid valve and water distribution system.

Water saving bypass models (WBP Series) deliver 100% of the water used in the form of vapor. A great choice for those with high municipal water costs, well water systems, septic systems, or where hot water is used for humidification.



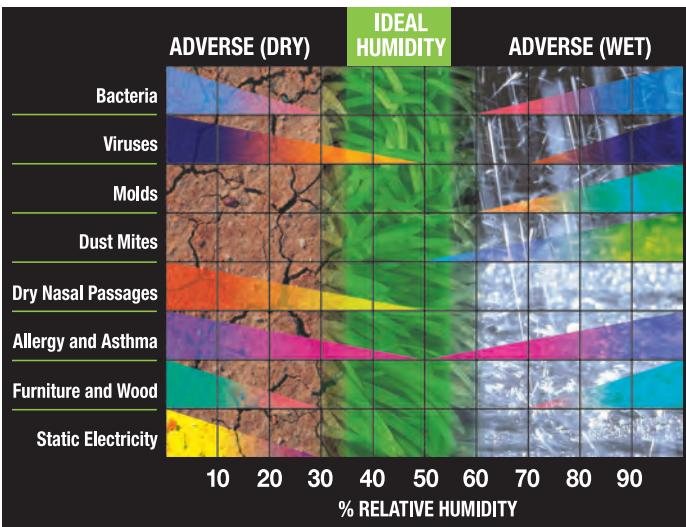
